### **SHOOT / EVENT CANCELLATION POLICY**

#### **POLICY No.10**

#### **PROCEDURE**

The South Australian Clay Target Association Inc (SACTA) publishes a program of clay target events that are conducted by member clubs within the Association. This program is provided to the membership in a booklet form and is also published on the internet on the SACTA website.

Clubs at times have found that they have a reason to cancel or readvertise a shoot for another day than that which is advertised. Without the appropriate notification this can cause embarrassment for competitors that attend at the incorrect time or for the association or club that has reprogrammed the shoot.

To assist in alleviating this problem, the following procedure is to be adopted when there is any change to the programming date or time for a shoot or event.

- 1. The South Australian Clay Target Association is to be advised in writing of the change;**
- 2. The Zone Secretary is to be advised in writing of the change;**
- 3. The club making the change is to advertise the change in the CTSN (Clay Target Shooting News) prior to the original date, advising of the changes to the program or day of competition, and/or**
- 4. The SACTA webmaster to be provided with the new program and dates for publishing on the SACTA website.**

Each club should minimise any changes after the program book has been published for any year and changes are only to be made when there is no other recourse for the club concerned.

This policy is to be read in conjunction with all SACTA policies and the Shooting Rules of the Australian Clay Target Association.
