SAFE STORAGE OF AMMUNITION AND FIREARMS POLICY

POLICY No.11

PROCEDURE

Member clubs of the South Australian Clay Target Association Inc (SACTA) at times may have ammunition and / or firearms on their premises. Member clubs have been the subject of unannounced venue audits of members of the South Australia Police Firearms Section and with this in mind clubs are forthwith required to comply with the Firearms Act and Regulations in South Australia.

Clubs are to be proactive in relation to the safe storage of ammunition and firearms by members that attend the club, by regularly making their members and visitors aware of the requirements on each person, regarding the requirements of the South Australian Firearms Act and Regulations.

Clubs are also required to comply with the requirements of the Firearms Act, in relation to the safe storage of ammunition and / or firearms that are kept on the premises for sale, safe keeping or as prizes.

This policy is to be read in conjunction with all SACTA policies, the Shooting Rules of the Australian Clay Target Association and the South Australian Firearms Act and Regulations.
