CODE OF CONDUCT

POLICY ON SUSPENSION

POLICY No.5

PROCEDURE

The Australian Clay Target Association provides suspension clauses for the safety of members that are attending at a clay target facility.

The safety clauses are detailed in the Rules of the Association in 1.1 – Safety. Any breaches of those safety rules require action to be taken by club management and the State Association.

The rules of the ACTA outlining investigation and suspension of members are detailed below:

1.1 SAFETY

(d) Firing the gun from any position other than orthodox (from the shoulder) is prohibited, with the exception of someone with a physical disability who has prior approval from a Rules Supervisor. Any shooter firing a gun from any position other than the shoulder will be immediately suspended by Club Management for one month, pending an investigation by a Rules Supervisor. The Rules Supervisor must provide a written report of the findings to the ACTA Board and a copy to the relevant State Association.

(k) Any shooter deliberately breaching any safety rule will be immediately suspended by club Management for one month, pending an investigation by a Rules Supervisor. The Rules Supervisor must provide a written report of the findings to the ACTA Board and a copy to the relevant State Association

(l) Any shooter committing an unsportsmanlike act on the shooting ground may be liable to suspension or disqualification

All clubs that are affiliated with the South Australian Clay Target Association will ensure that all rules as detailed in the current “Australian Clay Target Association Inc – Shooting Rules – Trap, skeet & ACTA Sporting, in relation to the suspension of members and the reporting of breaches is undertaken immediately upon the infringement occurring.

Once reported to the SACTA Executive, the Secretary shall take all steps necessary for the investigation of the reported breach and / or suspension.

This policy is to be read in conjunction with all SACTA policies and the Shooting Rules of the Australian Clay Target Association.
