2016 JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIP

The South Australian Clay Target Association is pleased to announce the continuation of the SACTA Junior Scholarship for promising young clay target shooters.

This scholarship is being provided by SACTA and is designed to support up and coming junior clay target shooters to achieve higher honours. One scholarship will be available each year. The scholarship will cover all aspects of clay target shooting that are under the umbrella of SACTA.

The scholarship is open to any SACTA registered shooter between the ages of 12 – 21 as at 31 December 2015.

The scholarship is available to those that are able to demonstrate commitment and development of their shooting involvement to the top echelons of the sport and want to extend themselves in national and international competition.

The scholarship

Each recipient will receive assistance from SACTA to the amount of \$1000.00 for use in the furtherance of their involvement in the sport.

- Selection criteria
- Recipients must:
- Have a proven track record in competition and demonstrate consistent skill and achievements.
- Be of good character and able to uphold the good name of SACTA.
- Be committed long-term to the sport.
- Be committed to training and coaching.
- Have a determination to succeed at the top levels of the sport.
- Be prepared to compete at national events in the coming year.

The application process

Those wishing to apply must complete an official application form (see below). SACTA will be responsible for awarding this scholarship via a selection panel to consist of representatives from SACTA. All information will be treated confidentially. No correspondence will be entered into after the selection process. Applicants will be advised in writing following selection.

- Selection criteria will include the following:
- Performance achievement to date
- Attitude and long term commitment
- Short and long term goals
- Proposed competition programme if Scholarship obtained
- Dedication to succeed at top level
- Independent candidate evaluation – a referee / reference

Applications for the 2016 – year scholarship should be sent to the SACTA Secretary no later than 22nd January 2016. No late entries will be considered.

A finalist will be selected from the applications. The successful recipient must agree to all terms and conditions of the scholarship programme and an official announcement and presentation will be made in February 2016 at the DTL State Carnival to be held at the State Shooting Park, Carmelo Road, Virginia.
