CODE OF CONDUCT

POLICY ON SUSPENSION

POLICY No.5

PROCEDURE

The Australian Clay Target Association provides suspension clauses for the safety of members that are attending at a clay target facility.

The safety clauses are detailed in the Rules of the Association in 1.01 – Safety. Any breaches of those safety rules require action to be taken by club management and the State Association.

The rules of the ACTA outlining investigation and suspension of members are detailed below:

1.01 SAFETY

(d) Firing the gun in any position other than orthodox, ie to the shoulder, is prohibited (with the exception of a physical disability). Any shooter firing a gun from any position other than orthodox will be immediately suspended by the Club Management and reported in writing to the Executive Committee – a minimum penalty of three months suspension shall apply.

(k) Any shooter knowingly breaching any safety rule other than 1.01(d), will be immediately suspended by the Club Management for one (1) calendar month pending an investigation into their actions by the relevant State Association and the ACTA must be notified of all breaches and responses.

(l) Any shooter committing an unsportsmanlike or unsafe act on the shooting ground shall be liable to suspension or disqualification.

All clubs that are affiliated with the South Australian Clay Target Association will ensure that all rules as detailed in the “Australian Clay Target Association Inc – Shooting Rules – Trap, skeet & ACTA Sporting – effective 1st January 2006; revised January 2018” are adhered to, and any action as detailed in Rule 1.01, in relation to the suspension of members and the reporting of breaches is undertaken immediately upon the infringement occurring.

Once reported to the SACTA Executive, the Secretary shall take all steps necessary for the investigation of the reported breach and / or suspension.

This policy is to be read in conjunction with all SACTA policies and the Shooting Rules of the Australian Clay Target Association.
